- Outpatient Psychotherapy provided at various locations throughout the state.
- Clinical consultations for psychiatric emergency services/screening centers (available 24/7 by phone) and on-site consultation when commitment of a deaf person appears likely. For <u>in-patient units</u> phone/on-site consultation is available to the treatment team:
  - Communication/language assessment
