QUALIFICATIONS NEEDED BY APPLICANT TO BE CONSIDERED FOR A GRANT:

Funds will be used to provide comprehensive cancer screening services to low-income women and men who are uninsured/underinsured. Federal funding is to be used to provide program-eligible women with age-appropriate breast and cervical screening and diagnostic services; State appropriated funds are to be used to provide age-appropriate breast, cervical and colorectal cancer screening to women and colorectal and prostate cancer screening to men

APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

Eligible applicants will submit grant applications through the Department's System for Administering Grants Electronically (SAGE), in accordance with the Request for Applications (RFA). The RFA may be requested from the contact listed below.

Applicants must have 501(c)(3) status and must have experience delivering health care services to the target population.

Applicants must have experience in the provision of medical services to the target population and have access to specialized staff [clinical providers, health educators, case managers/patient navigators, etc.] to conduct grant activities.

Applicants must have a valid NJ Tax Clearance Certificate and a valid NJ Charities Registration Letter of Compliance (if applicable) submitted with their application.
