PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS SHALL BE USED:

To improve postpartum health outcomes for birthing individuals, infants, and their families, with an emphasis on supporting undeserved populations including minority and socioeconomically disadvantaged individuals. To improve birth outcomes and achieve equity in maternal and infant health while reducing the stigma surrounding postpartum depression.

For Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS): Provide bereavement support, identify causes and risk factors, and conduct public health education for parents, grandparents, healthcare and social service institutions, home visiting programs, and many other groups related to SIDS. SIDS is a sudden death within the 12 months of life that remains unexplained after evaluation.
