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QUALIFICATIONS NEEDED BY APPLICANT TO BE CONSIDERED FOR A GRANT:

Qualified applicants must demonstrate the ability to work with the public and resource agencies to address a broad range of housing deficiencies (including the lead-based paint) and associated health hazards. Applicants must also demonstrate the ability to collaborate with health care providers to promote age-appropriate screenings and medical home model. Applicants must provide blood lead screening, nurse case management and environmental investigation services in compliance with N.J.A.C. 8:51.
